AOFAS will list dates on the AOFAS calendar, in In~Stride and FAI calendars of meetings only, as indicated on the application form under Endorsement Fees and Options. Placement in In~Stride and FAI calendars will be made pursuant to approval and according to next publication within standing print schedule.

Endorsement applications must be received a minimum of 4 months prior to meeting date. AOFAS requires a minimum of 3 weeks from date of application receipt for review, approval and subsequent placement in online calendars.
